Horizon 2020: SC1 Work Programme


- The 2020 Work Programme responds to the European Commission's political priorities and paves the way for its successor programme (Horizon Europe)
- the largest budget/year in the history of the EU Framework Programmes – ca. € 700 million/year for collaborative Health research (SC1)




